- An **Orientation Seminar on Traffic Law Enforcement** based on R.A. 4136 was given to 42 new traffic enforcers and to the deputized traffic enforcers of this Center, as re-orientation, last July 19 and 20, 2011, respectively. The said seminars was initiated by the Land Transportation Office Region XI and the Traffic Management Center thru Ms. Eleanor Calderon, Chief of Operations Division of LTO XI and the Officer-In-Charge of this Center.

- This Center participated in the weekly **Public Utility Vehicles Driver's Seminar** sponsored by the Office of the City Mayor. A total of **18,456** drivers have undergone the said seminar from October 2010 to December 2011.

### **3. ENGINEERING**

1. Fabrication / Rehabilitation of traffic signages.
2. Painted pedestrian lane in front of Quezon Elementary School and Roxas Elementary School along Ponce St., Davao City on March 5, 2011.
3. Installed rope and steel barriers along J.P.Laurel Avenue fronting Gaisano Mall, Bajada on March 9, 2011.
4. Rehabilitation of yellow box in front of Ateneo University of Davao along Matina in preparation for school year 2011 on June 5, 2011.

### **4. OTHER ACTIVITIES**

- Traffic Management and Control at DAVCON, Torres St., and Masonic Temple, V.Mapa St., Re: **Convention of Free Masons**, about 3,000 delegates and hundreds of vehicles were completely managed last April 29-30, 2011 – 10 TMC personnel detailed in the area.
- **17<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention of the National Federation of Motorcycle Club** held at MTS, Matina on April 30, 2011. About 1,700 delegates with foreign guests attended. 15 TMC Personnel and 4 Motorcycle units detailed.
- Escort **Presidential Visit** on April 20, 2011 – 6 motorcycle units / 2 mobile units / 12 TMC personnel detailed.
- **Bomb Drill** – Traffic responses were duly coordinated at Marco Polo last May 10, 2011. Participated by various government agencies: TF Davao, PNP, 911, Bomb Squad and 18 TMC personnel.
- **Abreeza Ayala Mall Grand Opening** – May 12, 2011. 25 TMC personnel managed traffic direction and control. Focused and quick responses were the key during the days of traffic congestions in that area.
- **Blood Letting Program** sponsored by Red Cross – May 21, 2011 and October 29, 2011. 30 TMC personnel undergone screening test.
- **Santa Cruzan sa Davao**, sponsored by the City Government held last May 21, 2011 from Recto-Palma Gil to San Pedro Cathedral with 1,000 participants. Simultaneous with that event, A Marian Procession from San Pedro Cathedral to Legaspi St., to Palma Gil-C.M.Recto St. to San Pedro Cathedral with 100 participants was conducted. 20 TMC personnel assist and manage the flow of traffic.

- **Grand Marian Procession** held last May 28, 2011 under the stewardship of Msngr. Paul A. Cuizon, JCD with 2,500 participants, 35 statues of Virgin Mary, 25 religious groups under Archdiocese of Davao. Escorted by 15 TMC Personnel and Motorcycle units.

- **Mandatory Drug Test** In keeping with the agenda of the current administration to create a drug free environment and employees in government agencies, this center subjected all of its 320 field and office personnel in a mandatory drug testing in cooperation with the office of DCDTRCDD, CHO, PDEA last August 20, 2011. Results were submitted by the PDEA XI to the Office of the City Mayor.
- **TMC Oplan Transport Strike Traffic Responses** on March 31 and September 17, 2011 on the deployment of buses and trucks to different areas in Davao City to Matina, Bangkal, Ulas, Puan, Talomo, Toril and Calinan, likewise going North, Bajada, Buhangin, Mandug, Cabantian, Lanang, Sasa, Panacan, Tibungco, Bunawan up to Lasang, from 5:00 AM to 10:00 PM. TMC deployed 68 buses from different bus companies and 20 government dump trucks.

- Responded a total of **91 Recorredas, 42 Parades/Processions, 165 Motorcades, 105 Fun Runs**. In every activities scheduled in the city streets, this center has been deploying personnel to assist the participants in their chosen routes, as well as the regulation and control of vehicular traffic in the streets affected. In the early hours of the dawn, the engineering section is already out in the streets to install signages and our traffic enforcers are already set on their posts.
- **OPLAN KALULUWA**. Traffic Management Center concurrent with its functions is primarily tasked to oversee the peaceful and smooth movement of motor vehicles and pedestrians to the highest level of road safety. The operation conducted by deploying a maximum number of Traffic Enforcers along the routes to and from the different cemeteries. Proper traffic signages were strategically placed to guide the motorists on its proper routes as well as the advisories for guidance even to those other motorist to avoid being trapped along the way to the destination.
- **PASKO FIESTA** In line with the activities prepared by the Local Government of Davao for the holiday season, TMC prepared and responded with Traffic personnel detail, traffic schemes and traffic control and direction for every activity each day.
